Guidelines On When To Keep A Student Home From School

FEVER - Stay home at least 24 hrs from onset of fever > 100°. Return when fever-free without the help of fever-reducing medication.

VOMITING*, **DIARRHEA****- Stay home at least 24 hrs from onset and until able to eat and drink normally.

*Not from a known condition ** ≥ 2 loose stools above normal

COUGH, COLD SYMPTOMS - Stay home if sore throat, cough, stomach ache, body aches, headache or exhaustion severe enough to interfere with learning.

HEADACHE - Stay home if severe enough to interfere with learning. If following a head injury, contact your healthcare provider.

INFECTION - If prescribed antibiotics, stay home until on antibiotics for 24 hours.

SKIN CONDITION - Stay home if new rash or spots. Cover open sores. May return if gone or if allowed by health care provider as safe for school.

EARACHE - If moderate to severe ear pain, call your healthcare provider.

MEDICATION AT SCHOOL

If medication is needed at school, complete a Medication Authorization Form and have an adult bring to school in the original container.

DOCTOR'S NOTE

If absent 3 days in a row or 10 days total for an illness, a doctor's note is required upon return to school.

Contact the school nurse if a health condition is affecting attendance.

Report communicable diseases to your school nurse

(such as covid, chicken pox, hand foot & mouth disease or strep throat)
