## **REMINDERS BEFORE REGISTERING:**

- Kindergarten Readiness and K-1 Transition take place at Parkview Elementary.
- All other classes take place at Riverview.
- No swimming lessons will be offered at summer school this year. Please contact the Plymouth Aquatic Center for swimming lesson opportunities.
- Full Morning = 5 – 45 minutes classes or a combination of 45 minute classes and 90 minutes classes which total 225 minutes.
- Bus students need to schedule a full morning.
