The Plymouth School District is dedicated to providing a nurturing experience for all families in our four-year-old kindergarten programs.

In four-year-old kindergarten our philosophy emphasizes a collaborative community approach that allows for minimizing transitions for children while providing a quality learning environment. On the back side of this announcement please find detailed information regarding our collaborative partners: ***Berry Branch Childcare in the elementary schools, Growing Generations Childcare at Generations and Head Start at Generations.***

The learning environment is designed to foster independence, encourage creativity, provide for social growth and challenge new learning. Four-year-old kindergarten placement is determined at the district level. 4K placement is made independent of elementary school placement to support fewer transitions in a child's day. 4K placement may be different than elementary placement which is intended to be your child's placement for their elementary years.

To complete the enrollment process, please download the following items from the enrollment page of our website <http://www.plymouth.k12.wi.us/> and bring the completed forms and a copy of your **child's birth certificate** and **immunizations record** to the Plymouth School District Office, located inside Plymouth High School at 125 Highland Avenue, by February 2nd. Your child must be 4 years old by or on Sept. 1, 2018.

Paper copies of the necessary forms will be available at the Plymouth School District Office if you are unable to access the website.

If your child will not be attending public school for 4K, please call the District Office at 892-2661. This will allow us to remove your child's name from our list and we will not bother you with follow up calls or requests for paperwork.

Placement information will be mailed to you in April and visitation will take place in August. Therefore, your child does not need to accompany you to enroll.
