In spring, registration papers were sent home to be completed and returned. If you still have these forms please bring them with you when you register. If the forms have been misplaced, please call the office at 892-4353 prior to coming so we can have new forms ready for you.

During registration students will receive their schedules and locker assignments. I invite and encourage all students to come in prior to the first day of school to put their school supplies in their lockers and gear up for a great school year. Riverview will be having our **“Open House”** on **Tuesday, August 30th from 4:00 P.M.-6:00 P.M.** for all students and parents. We hope you take advantage of coming to school to meet teachers, walk through classrooms, practice their schedules and ask any questions you might have regarding the upcoming school year.
