

Plymouth School District Laptop Protection Plan

What is and is not covered?

X Any accidental damage to the Laptop is covered as long as all school rules and procedures were being followed when the damage occurred.

X Laptops left unattended in non-secure locations (buses, locker rooms, bleachers, hallways, street corners) are NOT covered.

X Lost or stolen Laptops are NOT covered – if a Laptop is stolen from your home, it should be covered by your home owners insurance.

X Broken or lost chargers are not covered

X Intentional damage or obvious neglect is not covered. Some examples include writing on surfaces, attaching stickers, jamming foreign objects in the ports or drives, attempting to make repairs, cigarette burns, etc. This is not meant to be a complete list – only some examples.

X “I don’t know what happened” will not be accepted as a reason.

WARRANTY COVERAGE NOTES:

Any problems that determines to be product defects will be repaired under warranty. Plymouth will reject warranty repairs if the Laptop shows signs of excessive abuse. Some examples of warranty repairs:

- Bad hard drives and / or logic boards.
- Keyboards with missing keys. (unless they have been intentionally removed)
- Chargers that do not charge but show no signs of damage.
