**WELCOME.** The meeting was called to order at 6:03 pm.

**Treasurer's Report.** The copier order has been placed. We had one refund of \$100 for a student who did not attend Lakeland Music Camp. Current balance is roughly \$9,800 minus \$3,800 for the copier, which totals \$6,000 available.

**Secretary's Report.** There were no corrections to the minutes from the last meeting.
