Seniors: Do you need help completing your FAFSA application?

WHAT: Help completing the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)

BRING: You will need the following items in order to complete your FAFSA. If you are considered a dependent student for financial aid purposes, you will also need these items for your parent(s).

- 2018 Federal Tax Return and W2s.
- 2018 Untaxed Income Records, such as child support or veteran's non-education benefits
- Information on savings, investments, business assets and farm assets (if applicable)
- Driver's License (if you have one)
- Cell phone (if you have one)
- Social Security Number
- Alien Registration Card or Permanent Resident Card (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- Date of birth for parents
- Month and year of parents' marriage, divorce or separation
- FSA ID (if you have one). Visit fsaid.ed.gov to create an FSA ID (for assistance call 1-800-433-3243)
 - Every student and at least one parent of a dependent student will need an FSA ID
 - If parent already has an FSA ID or has more than one child attending college, the parent will use the same FSA ID to sign all applications
 - Each child must have their own FSA ID
 - Each FSA ID user must have a unique mobile phone number and/or email

It is highly recommended that a dependent student attend the event with a parent so the FAFSA can be submitted that evening.
