Plymouth Youth Center

The Youth Center offers a safe after-school option for middle-school students, with at least one adult present at all times.

Who: Students in grades 5-8 living in the Plymouth School district who attend public or parochial schools or are homeschooled

Where: Plymouth Youth Center, 609 North St. (next to Riverview Middle School)

When: until 5 p.m. after regular school days

Fee: \$50 per year
(or bundle with sports for savings)

Notes to parents:

- The Youth Center is not childcare, but a safe place with adult supervision. Students check in as they arrive and then come and go as they please.
- The Youth Center offers activities daily to interested students, including simple meals, relaxation, recreation, team building, and crafts.
- Organized activities are optional, and the Youth Center also is a safe place to hang out with friends and play pool, ping pong and foosball.
- Food is often provided as part of the programming, and healthy snacks (no candy or soda) are available for purchase.
