

Parents and Middle School Athletes:

Each year students from 5th grade through 8th grade have the opportunity to participate in various athletics at the middle school level. The middle school athletic program is run through Community Education and Recreation. This allows all potential student athletes living in the Plymouth School district the opportunity to participate, including private school students, homeschooled, etc.

Following the rules of the WIAA, each athlete must have a physical examination every 2 years, which includes the completion of a form by a physician. On the “off” years, students still need to complete an alternate physical card. To ensure that your student can begin their sport as soon as practices begin, it is in your best interest to complete physicals and Extracurricular Forms Packet as soon as possible. Forms must be completed & returned **prior** to child’s participation.

Extracurricular Forms Packet: (ALL forms are required for ALL extra curricular activities)

Included in Packet:

- ✓ Registration and Fee Form
 - This form is used to track the individual or multi-activities registrations for each student. This form is also used to track the fee collection for the school year
- ✓ Emergency contact
 - This form is used in an emergency, by the coaches, during a practice or game in which the legal guardian may not be present. This form contains insurance and hospital preference along with contact information.

******NOTE: Physical and Alternate cards are good from April 20 of that year through April 19th of the next year.******

- ✓ Physical form – Every other year
 - This form is used by the school district to track the student’s most current physical evaluation. This form is completed by the student’s physician every other year.
- ✓ Alternate year physical form – Every other year
 - This form is used by the school district to track the student’s most current physical evaluation. This form is completed by the student’s legal guardian and represents the alternate year of a physical evaluation.
- ✓ Concussion waiver – Prior to the start of the school year. WI State Law #118.293
 - This form is used by the school district to make sure each, participant and their legal guardian of an activity, under the age of 19, has been warned of the risk of concussion during activity.

The required forms can be found under the Community Ed. and Rec. link on the Plymouth School District website, under the Riverview Extracurricular tab under the common download section. There are also informational forms in that location including, Annual Snapshot of events; schedules and more on the specific sports.
