PJSD Residence Questionnaire 1

Your child may be eligible for additional services through the Federal McKinney-Vento Assistance Act. Eligibility can be determined by completing this questionnaire.

If you are a parent/guardian or caretaker enrolling a student/students. Check all that apply.

- Are you sharing the housing of another person due to economic hardship?
- Do you live in a hotel, motel, or campground because you have no other place to live?
- Are you living in a shelter?
- Do you live out of your car or any other place not designed as a place to live?
- Is your housing situation temporary?

If you are a student enrolling yourself, please answer the following questions, check all boxes that apply.

- Are you living alone as a minor student(s) without an adult (unaccompanied youth)?
- Are you staying with friends or family, other than your parent or guardian?
- Are you currently living away from your parent or guardian?
- Are you staying in a shelter, hotel, motel, campground, car or any place not intended for people to live?

Students who qualify have certain educational rights and may qualify for additional services. **If checked any of the boxes above, please complete the PJSD Homeless Identification Form.**

If you did not check any of the boxes above, you currently do not qualify.

Your child(ren) have the right to:

- Continue to attend school in the school attended before you became homeless (school of origin).
- Receive transportation to the school of origin.
- Enroll in school without giving a permanent address and attend classes while the school arranges for school transfer, immunization records or other documents required for enrollment.
- Receive the same special programs and services, if needed, as provided to all other children served in these programs.
- Have enrollment disputes quickly addressed.

The McKinney-Vento Homeless Education Assistance Act and the PJSD Board of Education Policy #5111.01 ensure the educational right above for students who are homeless.
