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PLYMOUTH EDUCATION FOUNDATION NEW GRANTS APPLICATION DEADLINE IS FEBRUARY 13th, 2017

PLYMOUTH, Wis.—January 9th, 2017—The Plymouth Education Foundation(PEF) will award \$10,000 in Grants to Plymouth School District (PSD) Staff, as well as to PSD Students and/or Plymouth Community Members who partner with PSD Staff. The Foundation’s Grant application deadline is February 13, 2017.

This is the second year in the Foundation’s newest initiative which will enhance the educational experience for students in the Plymouth School District by inspiring innovation, building strategic partnerships, and creatively engaging students at all levels in the district—high school, middle school, and elementary school.

Theater Technology and Design Course Professional Support: Applicant was Janet DeJean Newton: PHS impact expected; \$1,675 award.

Improved Recycling Attitudes and Practices: Applicants were PHS biology teacher Tina Henriksen and PHS head custodian Bob Mueller; district wide impact expected; \$1,000 award.
