

Hello,

In order to best communicate with parents about important and time sensitive information, we are implementing a new service called Skylert powered by School Messenger. This program connects to your Skyward family access account. We need your help to verify and update phone numbers. The phone numbers that you choose will be the numbers that we use to communicate these important messages. If you'd like to receive text notifications, be sure to include your mobile phone number. Follow these simple steps to be assured that you receive communications in the form that you request.

Step 1 – Log into Skyward.

Step 2 – On the left side of the Skyward screen click on the link labeled Skylert.

Step 3 – Verify that the phone numbers on this page are valid and accurate. These are the phone numbers that will be used to communicate with parents via phone (voice) and SMS (text messages).

Step 4 – School Messenger will send out a text message to any newly added phone numbers listed on the Skylert page. When you receive the text, type "y" or "yes" (without the quotes) to opt-in to receive text messages from Plymouth School District. **If yes don't receive a text, then text yes to 67587.**

You can also opt out of these messages at any time by simply replying to one of our messages with “**Stop**”.

i [Information on SMS text messaging and Short Codes:](#)

SMS stands for Short Message Service and is commonly referred to as a “text message”. Most cell phones support this type of text messaging. Our notification provider, SchoolMessenger, uses a true SMS protocol developed by the telecommunications industry specifically for mass text messaging, referred to as “short code” texting. This method is fast, secure and highly reliable because it is strictly regulated by the wireless carriers and only allows access to approved providers. If you’ve ever sent a text vote for a TV show to a number like 46999, you have used short code texting.
